St Mildred's it has been absolutely fantastic to see all the maths you are doing at home and even better to see your fantastic pictures. Thank you to everyone who has sent a picture.



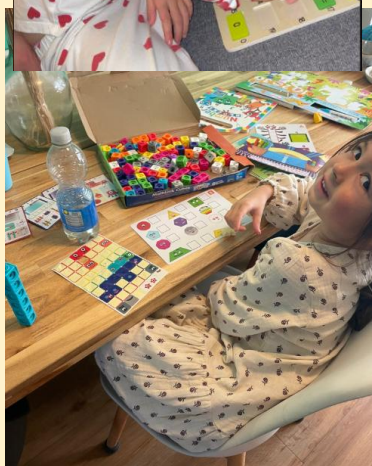
Percy in Viking Bay made a giant snakes and ladder game for her brother to play

Maths at Work

Wilbur in Louisa Bay's mummy works as an architect and has written a short paragraph about how she uses maths in her job:

"Hello my name is Elizabeth and I work as an architect. I design buildings and do drawings to help the builders when building them.

I use maths within my job in lots of different ways. I need to do lots of measuring to make sure the buildings will fit on their sites. It also helps people to know what furniture will fit inside their houses. Sometimes I have to count the bricks to work out how tall a building is. I use my times table knowledge to work out the area of a room. I also have to use lots of different shapes to help me with my drawings. Builders have to use a special ruler to measure my drawings and work out how big the buildings should be in real life!"
