Maths at Work

Finns mum in Botany Bay's mum works as a customer's insight manager.

Hello, my name is Carla Allen and I work as a Customers Insight Manager. In my job I talk to people about how they use the internet on computers and mobile phones to understand what they find difficult, what they might be missing and what worries them. By using that information we can invent new ideas to help make things easier and most importantly safer online.

As part of my job I need to survey people. This means I have to ask lots of questions to hundreds and thousands of people. I then have to use the responses and turn these into fractions and percentages. We can also show people brand new products and ask them questions about these and then again a year later and compare the answers. I also use a programme on my computer called excel which helps me to calculate the percentages, do really tricky calculations at the touch of a button which makes my job much easier! To make things more interesting we put the percentages in charts using another computer programme, PowerPoint so it is easier to see at a glance if something is bigger or smaller.
