Back to School Reminders



Coming in:

Please wait behind the yellow line and then once your child sees their teacher or member of SLT they can come straight into school. The school doors open from 8.30 until 8.40 so remember you can come any time in that window. Please try to avoid coming up to the entrance doors as we need to keep it clear for children to be able to come in safely.

Going home:

We appreciate that this is busy and a letter came out this week to show you where to wait for your class. This should help reduce congestion and again, we ask you to remain behind the yellow line, including older siblings. Teachers will then bring out the children and release them one at a time to you as they see you. This can take some time but ensures children safely reach you so do bear with us.

Please can we also ask that you walk around the yellow line to get to and from the Reception area as this keeps our Year 1 and 2 children safe when coming across to their parents.

If someone else is collecting your child please let us know via the office or speak to your child's teacher. For safeguarding, it is important to ensure we know who is collecting children.

Bags and Bookbags:

A reminder that children only need a school book bag. **No rucksacks** please as they do not fit easily in lockers.

PE Kits

Please make sure your child has a full PE kit in school for both indoor and outdoor PE. Please also ensure that everything is named.

If your phone number or email address has changed over the holidays please let the office know.

Water bottles:

Please make sure your child has a named water bottle in school every day with **water in only**.

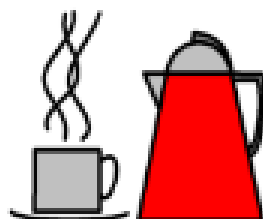
